According to the Federal Register/Volume 56 No. 44 dated Wednesday, March 6, 1991, the proposed regulations state: “Each pump equipped with dual mechanical sealing system that includes a barrier fluid system is exempt from the requirements of paragraph (b)” which dictates monitoring requirements and allowable leak levels. Pumps so equipped are classified the same as hermetic or magnetic drive pumps.
