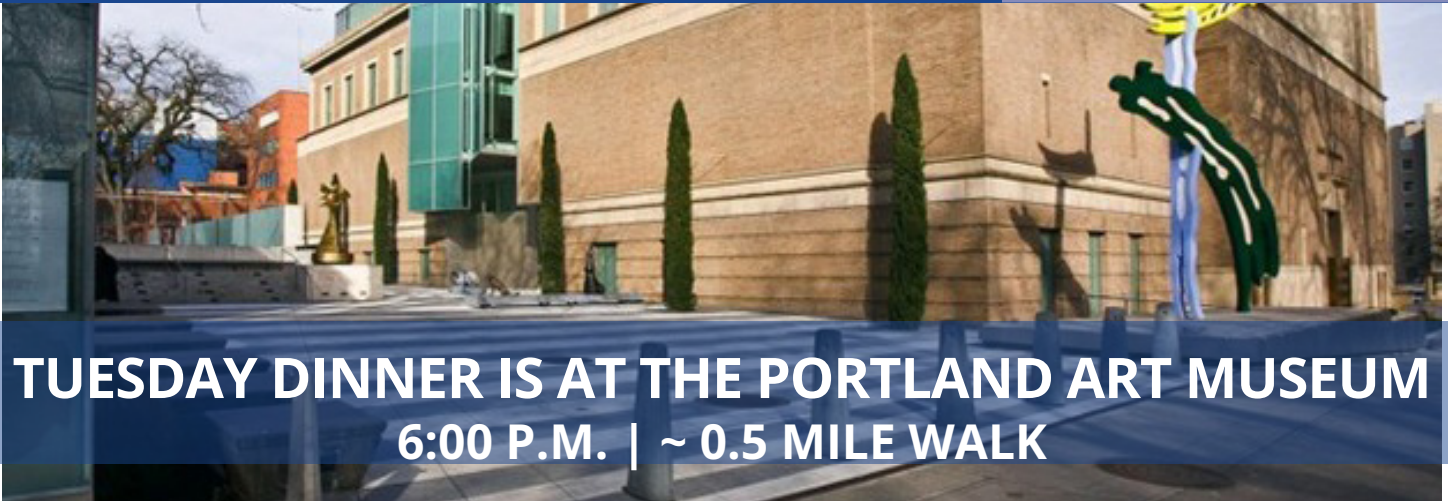

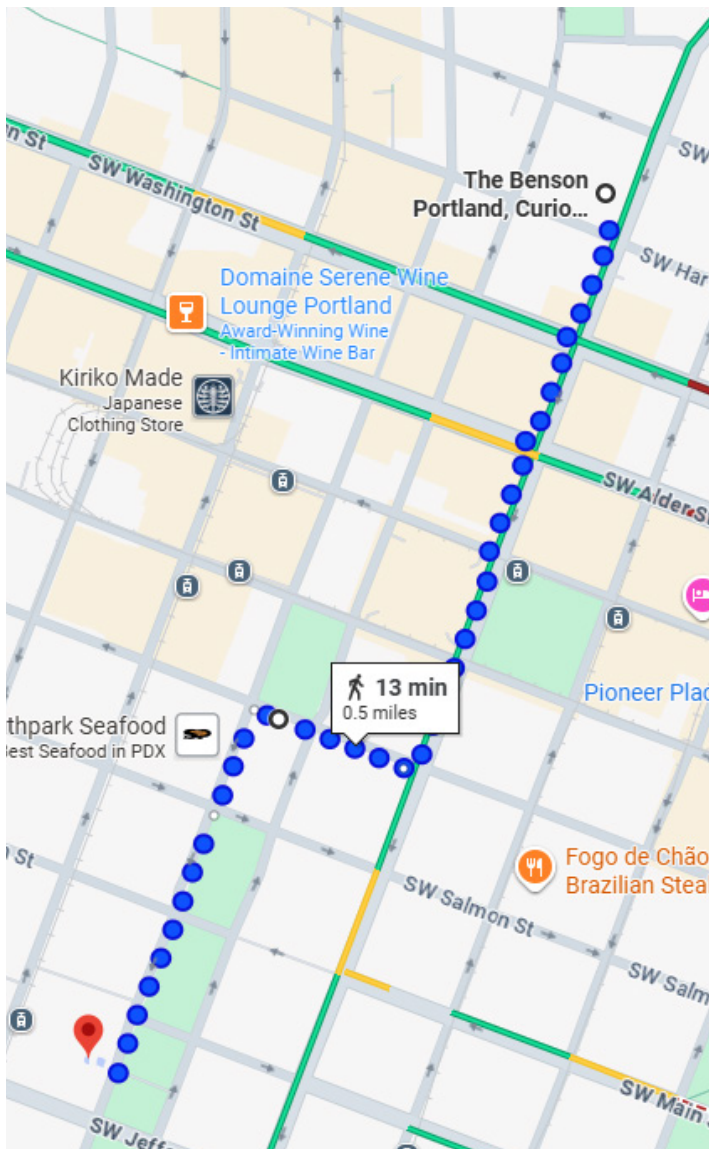

HERE'S THE EASY WALK—ABOUT 10-12 MINUTES (~0.5 MI):

1. Start at The Benson (309 SW Broadway). Turn **RIGHT** to head south on SW Broadway. The Benson Hotel
2. Continue to SW Taylor St.
3. Turn **RIGHT** (west) on SW Taylor St and walk 2 blocks to SW Park Ave (you'll pass through Director Park).
4. Turn **LEFT** (south) on SW Park Ave and follow the South Park Blocks a few blocks—the Portland Art Museum (1219 SW Park Ave) will be on your right between SW Madison & SW Jefferson.

The hotel sits about half a mile from the museum, so most folks make it in ~10-12 minutes at an easy pace.
